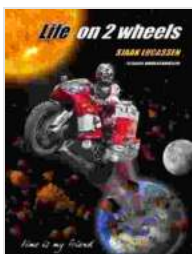


Life On Wheels: Part Out of North America Until the End

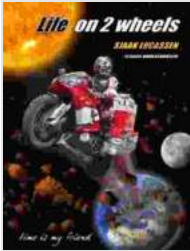
