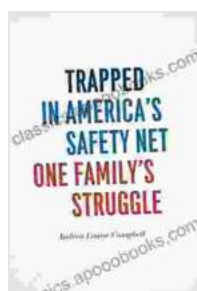

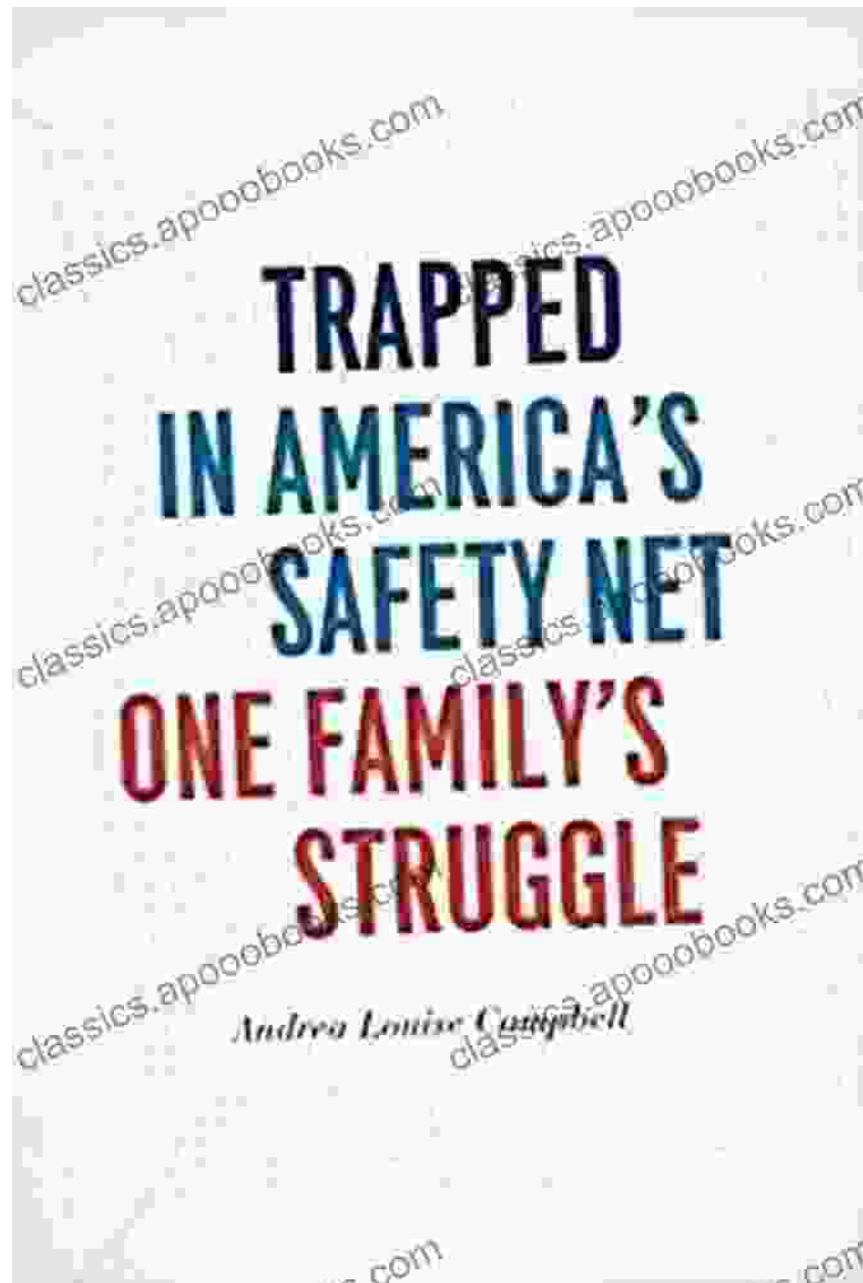

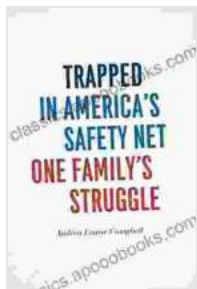


The author, Dr. Garcia, is a professor of sociology at the University of Chicago. She has written extensively about the experiences of immigrants in America.
