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The Photo-Essay:

The Photo Essay is one of the most important developments of 20th Century Photography. The Photo Essay's perfection is often credited to W. Eugene Smith (1918-1978), who popularized this type of professional photography.

The Photo Essay can be described as a group of photographs, usually with supplementary text, that analyze a subject from all angles. It is often used as a tool for social criticism or as a way to tell a story. To create a photo essay you can use candid photography, documentary photography, and photojournalism.

Project Details:

For your Final Project of January 1, you are being asked to create a Photo Essay. This is a more independent project but please ensure that it should embrace all of the techniques and methods you have learned from this year. This means my expectations for quality and time will be higher than your previous projects. Here are the regulations of the project:

- 1) Ten (10) Photographs
 - Strong composition
 - Creative lighting
 - NOT used for any other project
 - Total count of subject matter and theme
- 2) Each photograph must capture a moment
- 3) NOT take in one session through a common theme
- 4) Photographs in all sequences in order to tell a story
- 5) Each photograph must have a subject of interest (a person or something the camera has a distinct interest of the story) NOT used in the photograph
 - Do not simply describe the photograph
 - Express emotions that corresponds to the photo
 - The photographs can together
- 6) All ten (10) photographs must be presented in a PROFESSIONAL DISPLAY with the correct, spell-checked and grammatically correct

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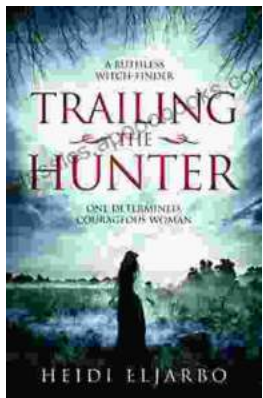
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
